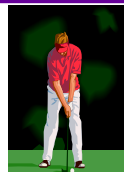

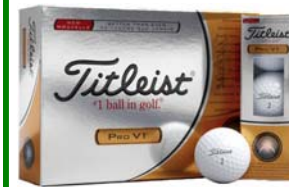

The course went through the winter in good shape. We did have one pine tree uprooted along the right side of #5 fairway, which was removed. We did not have the ice storms we have had the last couple of years, so clean up was not a major problem this year.

We have started working on sand traps, with cleaning and edging so they will be in good shape earlier this year. We are also getting ready to start putting out the golf supplies on the course. We are just waiting for the weather to stabilize a little. In the mean time, we are busy cleaning up areas and getting ready for the upcoming golf season.

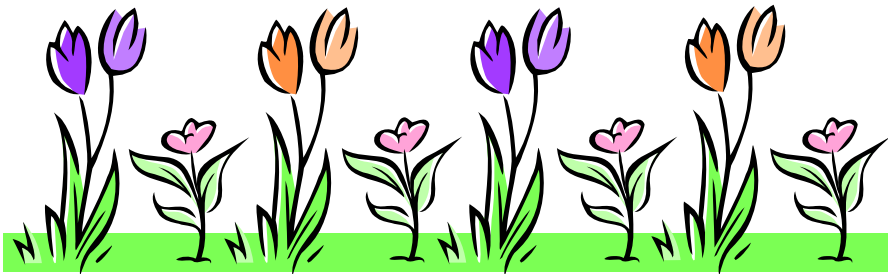

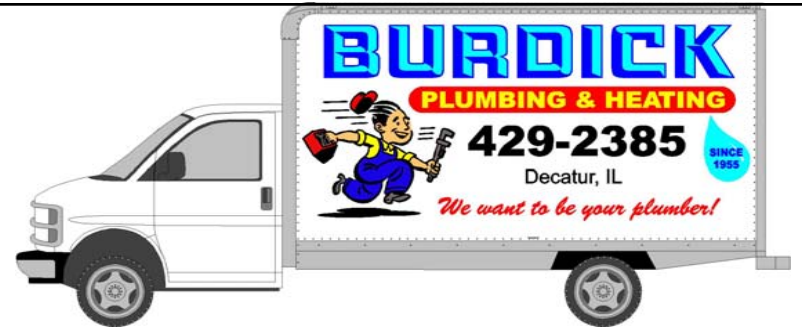
