Golf Tip of the Month

Rule Tip

Playing #15, your ball lands short of the bridge by the green and bounces into the water passing over red stakes.

What are your options?

- A. Play a ball as nearly as possible at the spot from which the original ball was last played.
- B. Drop a ball behind the water hazard, keeping the point at which the original ball last crossed the margin of the water hazard directly between the hole and the spot on which the ball is dropped, with no limit to how far behind the water hazard the ball may be dropped.

Because red stakes define a lateral water hazard, you have two additional options.

- C. Drop a ball outside the water hazard within two club lengths of and not nearer the hole where the original ball last crossed the margin of the water hazard.
- D. Drop at a point on the opposite margin of the water hazard equal distant from the hole.

The last option, allowing the player to drop a ball on the green side of the hazard thus taking the bridge and big tree out of play, is your best choice.

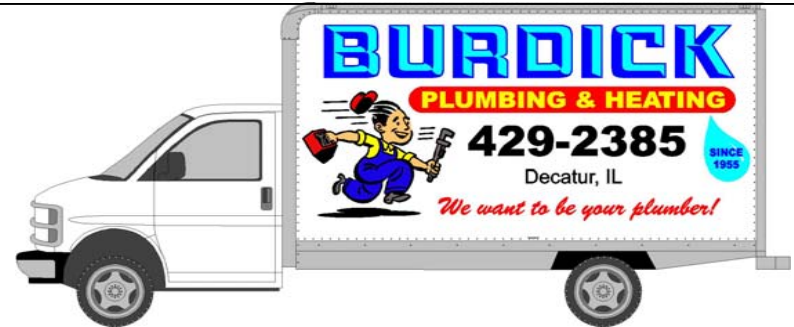

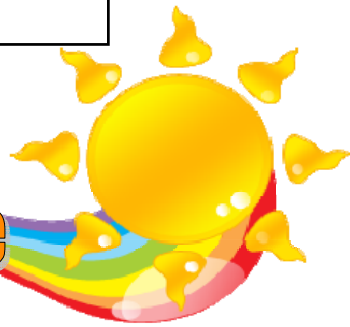
